### Before Arrival

Please self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19. If you are experiencing any symptoms or suspect you may have
or may have been exposed to COVID-19, do not attend the event in person – instead, you are welcome to watch

## On Arrival (Staff, volunteers, taiko drummers)

- Contact tracing information will be collected, along with a liability and photograph waiver. By attending this event in person, you acknowledge that you are not showing symptoms of illness or have reason to believe you may have currently or have been exposed to COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Your temperature will be checked by contactless forehead thermometer
- All volunteers & staff are expected and required to wear an appropriate face mask. We will have an extra to
  provide if you left yours at home

## During the event (All)

- Information will be collected for contact tracing by PSFS staff, along with a declaration of health
- Masks are recommended for all attendees
- PSFS Staff will circulate to ensure there is appropriate physical distance in queues and communal areas, and to monitor mask wearing among staff and volunteers
- Event will be configured to allow appropriate distance between performers/participants and attendees, and for safe physical distancing between attendees
- Hand-to-hand passing of items is to be avoided as possible; specifically, items will be self-serve as much as possible
- Individuals are requested to please sanitize their hands frequently, especially before and after touching shared items and surfaces, their own faces or masks, using the washroom, eating, drinking, or handling food items
  - o Hand sanitizer will be provided near piles of Daruma, portable washroom, and food/drink distribution
- Individuals are encouraged to greet each other with a smile and wave as opposed to a hug or handshake
- Frequently touched objects will be cleaned regularly
- Attendees and participants are encouraged to leave, avoiding crowds, if they become ill or begin to show symptoms
